

WBGBA YOUTH PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION

Students may apply for funds for "Start-Up" and supplies for equipment, etc for the propagation of poultry/gamebirds/game animals or waterfowl. The student must be between 12 and 18 years of age.

They must present a plan in writing to the committee chairperson- right now it is Robert Popple- who will inform the rest of the committee to meet and make a decision re: application.

GRANT INFORMATION:

1. A recipient (s) will be determined by the grant award committee.
2. Grants will be awarded with the understanding that funds will be used to meet expenses for the propagation of poultry/ gamebirds/ waterfowl/ or game animals.
3. It is understood that anyone awarded a grant will complete a final report to be turned in to the committee chairperson. This final report must include pictures and an essay describing the project.

GRANT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Application **MUST BE TYPED** and be the current year's application. The deadline being the Spring Swap which is age.
3. Limit one grant per student per year.
4. Application must be signed by student and parent/guardian.
